Media Release

This afternoon (4/4/24) Noah Williams, 21, of Ann Arbor, was arraigned at 14A-1 District Court in two separate incidents. Williams is charged with assault with attempt to murder and assault with intent to do great bodily harm less than murder or by strangulation in connection to a stabbing incident that occurred on a AATA bus on 4/3/24. A 25-year-old female was slashed across her chest in the incident. The victim has since been released from the hospital.

Williams is also charged with assault with a dangerous weapon and misdemeanor assault and battery in connection to an incident that occurred at the Target store on 231 S. State Street, on 4/1/24. It is alleged Williams produced a knife and placed it against the throat of a 32-year-old male after the two bumped into each other inside the store.

Williams was given a bond of \$750,000 cash/surety, no 10% in each incident. He remains lodged at the Washtenaw County Jail.
